At the VSO annual meeting January 2, 2006, Pat Keegan, Treasurer, reported **\$13,622** as the final results for 2005. All administrative expenses for this year were absorbed by the VSO board members. This means all funds go to the children at Vinh Son. We are extremely appreciative to all our donors who made this fantastic achievement.

The money will be used in the following manner:

- Basic Daily Needs (food, medicine, school supplies)
- The start-up of the Sewing Machine Project— a unique opportunity to provide and teach life skills
- Communication improvements, through computer upgrades and maintenance

Disbursements of funds began June 30, 2005. The first one was for \$1,200 to meet basic daily needs. At our January 2 VSO Annual Meeting, we gave Sister Marie Dominique a check

for \$3,200 to wire to the orphanage..

The second disbursement will occur when Dave Chaix and Pat Keegan visit the orphanage in February to implement the Sewing Machine project and the computer upgrades to improve direct communication to the orphanage.

As we have stated previously, travel to Vietnam is not paid by VSO. VSO members pay for their own travel.
