Fundraising/Financial Update

This year, we had a record setting fundraising initiative. With support from our benefactors, we asked you to match \$46,650, and you answered with generosity that exceeded our wildest expectations. During the matching fund period of August-December, donations reached \$69,350! Even more impressive is the year-do-date total of \$187,082 vs. a target of \$125,000. Your support of the kids provides them with security, hope, and a future. But most importantly, they know that from far away...you care.

Message from the FVSO President

As 2015 comes to a close, I can look back and see what a marvelous year it has been. On behalf of the FVSO Board of Directors and myself, I want to thank for your generous support. The year has not closed yet, but I believe this will set a record year for donations, allowing us to do so much more to improve the lives of the kids at Vinh Son and Sao Mai. In addition to supporting basic needs throughout the year, we were able to deliver improved dental care, and kick-off a scholarship program for advanced education beyond high school, focused on trade schools and professional careers.
