



During the time I stayed in Saigon (Ho Chi Minh City), I saw a lot of beautiful things which only exist in a busy city. When I entered the city, I felt like I stepped into a totally different world. People's lifestyle is very different from Kontum. It is very strange to me because the city is much more advanced compared to Kontum.

When I came to the city, the only thing in my head was whether or not I could find the school to take the exam! I didn't think about doing anything else because things seemed so strange, and I was afraid. Many times I lost my way, but I did find the school and felt much better. The school was about one hour from where I was staying. One time I took a taxi, but the driver cheated me.
